Sub: Passing of Resolutions by way of Postal Ballot pursuant to Section 110 of the Companies Act, 2013, read with Rule 22 of the Companies (Management & Administration) Rules, 2014 and other applicable provisions of the Companies Act, 2013 and the rules thereunder in terms of the Notice dated May 27, 2015.

- 1. The Board of Directors of the Company at its meeting held on May 27, 2015 had appointed me as a Scrutinizer for conducting the postal ballot voting process and e-voting process for the above mentioned purpose.
- 2. I submit my report as under:
- 2.1. The Company has completed on 2nd June, 2015 the dispatch of postal ballot forms and PIN MAILERS along with postage prepaid reply envelopes to its Members whose name(s) appeared on the Register of Members/list of beneficiaries as on May 22, 2015.
- 2.2. Particulars of all the postal ballot forms received from the Members and the votes cast by electronic mode have been electronically entered in a register separately maintained for the purpose.
- 2.3. The envelopes containing postal ballot forms were dated, stamped on the envelopes and were kept under my safe custody in sealed and tamper proof ballot box before commencing the scrutiny of such postal ballot forms.
- 2.4. The ballot box was opened on July 02, 2015 after 5.30 p.m. in my presence along with two witnesses.
- 2.5. The postal ballot forms were duly opened in my presence and after verification of signatures at the office of the Registrar and Transfer Agents, the same were scrutinized and the shareholding was matched/ confirmed with the Register of Members of the Company/list of beneficiaries as on May 22, 2015 as per the summary furnished to the Company by the Registrar and Transfer Agents.
- 2.6. All postal ballot forms received up to the last date and time fixed by the Company for receipt of the forms were considered for my scrutiny.
